		Process and detailed content of the practice: The protection of biodiversity is carried out through three aspects: - information, training and education with the aim to arise consciousness on Nature 2000 sites in the area of Province Forli-Cesena and to prevent the sites integrity; - updating the databases of the Nature 2000 sites monitoring the natural and environmental aspects of the sites and operating a watching service by national and/or provincial rangers/police; - to create the favourable conditions for the improvement of the habitats and species, promoting the creation of the ecological network.
		Legal framework: Directives CEE 409/79 and 43/91; regional laws for the application of the above European directives and on environmental sustainability education (L.R. 7/2004, 6/2005 and 27/2009).  Financial framework: Region Emilia- Romagna, Province Forli-Cesena





6	Evaluation	Possible demonstrated results: - increased citizens' level of knowledge of the Nature 2000 sites in the area of Province Forlì-Cesena — - increased citizens' awareness for biodiversity protection - decrease of offences against the sites integrity; Possible success factors: - kind of methodology used - presence of a network of qualified public organisations/bodies Encountered difficulties: - the second and third aspect of the practice are going to be started in due time but difficulties caused by lack of financial resources and human resources are very likely.
