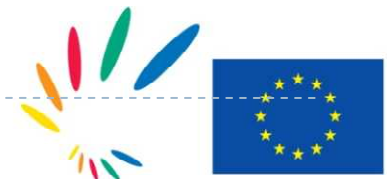




## Preparing for emergency

  - Guidelines for preparing emergency plans by the regulation no 15 of the Minister of Interior 08.06.2010

  - Consist of headquarters and field exercises carried out on state, regional and municipal level

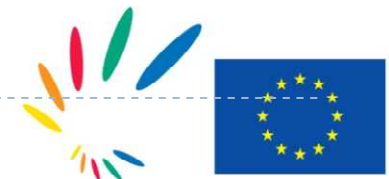




## Basics for creating the plan

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- Government has listed the emergencies that require the emergency plans and has appointed the state agencies to prepare these plans
- State agencies and other juridical bodies who will have an important information or who are participating in the processes of responding to emergencies are appointed by the Government to be included to the planning process

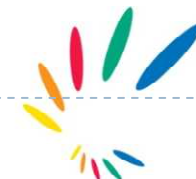




## Emergency Plan (EP)

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- EP is a document that describes on a state or if necessary on a regional or municipal level:
  - 1) Arrangement of responding to emergencies (ES)
  - 2) Management structure of responding to ES
  - 3) Responsibilities of agencies and individuals participating in ES
  - 4) Regulation of exchange of information between the agencies and individuals participating in ES
  - 5) Arrangement of informing the public of ES
  - 6) Organizing international co-operation in ES
  - 7) Other questions involved in ES





## Informing of emergency

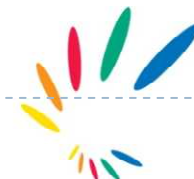
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The regulation no 57 “Informing Ministry of Interior in case of emergency or risk of emergency” of the Government from 06.05.2010

- It is compulsory for any office or legal body to inform the Ministry of Interior immediately of emergency or risk of emergency occurred in area of activities

The regulation no 92 “Requirements on informing the public of the risk of the occurrence of emergency, emergency and the response to emergency” of the Government from 01.07.2010

- The public has to be informed immediately in case of risk of occurrence of emergency, of emergency or response to emergency if the failure to inform may endanger the lives or health of people, cause major proprietary damage or otherwise disrupt the ordinary way of life

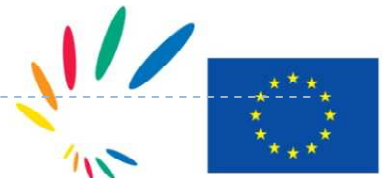




## Crisis management commissions (CMC)

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- 1) CMC of the Government
- 2) Regional CMC
  - Regional rescue services are required to create permanently working regional CMC's in their area
- 3) Municipal CMC
  - Municipalities are required to create permanently working municipal CMC's in their area





## Crisis management commission (CMC) Tallinn

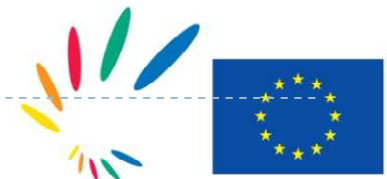
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CMC of Tallinn and its statute is approved by the regulation no 88 of the Tallinn City Government

The purpose of the CMC of Tallinn is to coordinate the activities of crisis regulation in their area – preventing ES, preparing of ES, responding to ES and mitigating the consequences of ES

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CMC of Tallinn consists of 18 members and the Head of the CMC of Tallinn is the Mayor of Tallinn

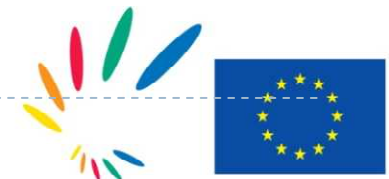




## Obligations of CMC of Tallinn in participating in responding to emergency

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- Assists agencies responding to emergencies of exchange of information
- Participates in carrying out the evacuations
- Guarantees transportation and shelter for evacuees (providing food, medical care and basic living conditions)
- Guarantees functioning of vital services in emergency situations



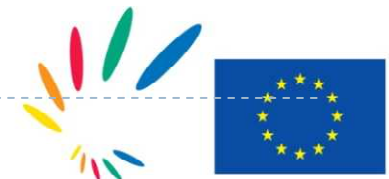




## The Team of Crisis Regulation of the CMC of Tallinn (TCRoCMCoT)

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- TCRoCMCoT was created by the decree no 43-k of the Tallinn City Government from 13.01.2010
- TCRoCMCoT was created to coordinate the exchange of information and co-operation between the different departments and for the analysis of the situations
- TCRoCMCoT consists of 39 members and the head of TCRoCMCoT is the Vice-mayor of Tallinn who is responsible for the crisis regulation





## Regulation of providing vital services

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Municipal unit organise the following vital services:

- 1) Functioning of district heating
- 2) Functioning of maintenance of city streets and roads
- 3) Functioning of water supply and sewerage
- 4) Functioning of waste management
- 5) Functioning of public transport in city

Municipal unit in organising the functioning of vital services:

- 1) Co-ordinates the activities to ensure functioning of the vital services and provide advice to providers of vital services
- 2) Carries out supervision of the vital services
- 3) Presents biannual reports to Ministry of Interior
